



## **Call for Papers**

The 10<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Radiation Safety and Detection (ISORD-10), which is organized by China Institute for Radiation Protection, the Cyclotron and Radioisotope Center (CYRIC) of Tohoku University (Japan) and the Innovative Technology Center for Radiation Safety (iTRS) of Hanyang University (Korea), is going to be held in July, 2019, Taiyuan, China.

The ISORD symposium was jointly initiated by Tohoku University, Hanyang University and China Institute for Radiation Protection in 2001. Since the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting in Seoul, it has been successfully held for 9 times, alternatively in Korea, Japan and China, and one in Malaysia. With growing influence, ISORD symposium has become a significant academic exchange activity in Asia and is committed to providing a platform for exchanging scientific and technical achievements in radiation safety and detection, showcasing products and services, discussing challenges faced by radiation protection and highlighting future developments.

By far, ISORD-10 has invited leading experts in the field of radiation safety and detection as special speakers at the plenary session, including President Roger Coates from the International Radiation Protection Association (IRPA), Prof. Pan Ziqiang from the Chinese Academy of Engineering, Prof. David K. Wehe from the University of Michigan, Prof. Chan Hyeong Kim from Hanyang University, Dr. Wu Yican from Chinese Academy of Sciences, Dr. Ioannis Giomataris from French Atomic Energy and Alternative Energies Commission (CEA), Dr. Maria Pia from Italian National Institute of Nuclear Physics (INFN) and Prof. Xiao Detao from the University of South China. The organizing committee of ISORD-10 is excited to invite experts, scholars, technicians as well as college teachers and students who are engaged in radiation safety and detection technology to attend the symposium and contribute

### **Instruction to Authors**

ISORD-10 calls for papers from scientific and technical professionals in the field of radiation protection around the globe. Authors are supposed to submit the abstract first. The full paper can be submitted after the abstract is approved by the Scientific Committee.

Papers approved will be included in the conference proceedings, and will be simultaneously be recommended to be published on the journal of China Society of Radiation Protection (CSRP) - *Radiation Protection* and on a special issue of the journal for ISORD-10, and on the *Health Physics* (Organized by the Health Physics Society in the United States) in abstracts. Outstanding papers of young scientists and college students will be granted special awards.

#### ◆ Paper requirements

Papers submitted should be those which have not been previously published or used for academic exchanges; content of papers submitted should be in line with the symposium topics and reflect latest progress and results of related researches; papers should be innovative and should not contain any confidential content.

#### ◆ Paper submission

Times New Roman 12pt, centered on the page

<sup>1</sup> *First affiliation with address, Country, (Times New Roman 12pt italics, centered)*

<sup>2</sup> *Second affiliation with address, Country, (Times New Roman 12pt italics, centered)*

<sup>3</sup> *Third affiliation with address, Country, (Times New Roman 12pt italics, centered)*

When preparing abstracts, please use this template without changing the format. Abstracts can only be submitted via the ISORD-10 website: <http://www.isord-10.org.cn>

The online submission system will be open on January 15, 2018. The submission due date is May 15, 2019. One paper submission is acceptable for per registration. Each presenting author is requested to register and pay in advance before 12 July, 2019 for inclusion of his/her presentation into the ISORD-9 program.

1: The abstract must be written in English on A4 size paper (21.0 x 29.7cm) with **top/bottom margins of 2.5 cm** and **left/right margins of 2.0 cm**. It cannot be longer than the **one-page** space that has been allotted.

2: For the heading (title, name of the author and address), follow the instructions above, and leave a blank line underneath the title.

3: The main text must be in Times New Roman **12pt** and in single spacing. Leave two blank lines between the heading and the main text. Indent and fully justify each new paragraph.

4: Formulae, equations and figures should be an integral part of the abstract, with captions in Times New Roman 11pt, and not submitted separately.

5: A short list of references can be added in Times New Roman 11pt.  
e.g. [1] S. Maeda and T. Iguchi, *J.Nucl.Sci.Technol.*, 50(4), pp.381-386, 2013.

6: For submission, please convert your abstract from a Word file to an **Adobe Acrobat PDF** while embedding all the fonts used in it (including those in figures, tables, and pictures) to avoid garbled printout. Please check your abstract carefully (for layout problems, missing figures and garbled characters, etc.) No security settings are allowed.

7. For the name of the abstract file, follow the format as below:
